ERASMUS+ OPERATING GRANT 2026 IN ACTION

Young voices, digital citizenship and democratic participation

A common framework for youth participation

Through the Erasmus+ Operating Grant, MVI is creating learning and collaboration opportunities for young people, youth workers, civil-society organisations and network partners. EYS 2026 combines non-formal education, intercultural dialogue and youth-led action to support more inclusive, informed and democratic communities.

Ten Digital Ambassadors mobilised

In July, MVI brought together ten young Digital Ambassadors from different MVI countries for the "Digital Ambassadors for Positive Online Change" workshop. Participants explored misinformation, hate speech, responsible digital citizenship and the role that young people can play in promoting democratic values online.

Young people as creators of positive online change

The workshop encouraged participants to see digital platforms not only as places where they consume information, but also as spaces for learning, participation and social impact. Through a co-creation process, they identified issues affecting young people online, developed campaign messages and considered target audiences, formats, tone, platforms and calls to action.

Voices Amplified moves into content production

Under the Voices Amplified campaign, young people are contributing to podcasts, a campaign video, infographics, social-media content and youth-generated articles. These materials address misinformation, hate speech, digital responsibility, democratic participation and the values of the EU Youth Dialogue.

PODCAST SPOTLIGHT: "DECODING DISINFO"

MVI has published Decoding Disinfo: Young Fact-Checkers vs. Hate Speech, a conversational podcast examining how misinformation spreads online, how stereotypes can develop into hate speech, and why empathy, respectful dialogue, verification and critical thinking are essential for healthier digital spaces.



Academy "Skills for Engagement & Impact"

Help us showcase the impact of youth work across our network!
